<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. For Ambulance - A club official will be waiting for the ambulance at the main gate (entry point). The Club Official will then direct the ambulance to the casualty.</li><li>2. First Aid Room to Ambulance – The side door to changing facilities (Players &amp; Officials entrance) will be opened for Medical staff and the medical staff will be greeted by physio/first aider.</li><li>3. Ambulance to pitch – access routes will always be made visible and the emergency services will be directed Onto the pitch via opening in barrier.</li></ol>
